



Broad Chest

There are several words used to describe the chest area. Broad, deep, heavy or wide to name a few.

A broad chest indicates leg placement as well as the skeletal and muscular structure to support the weight of an adult Red Wattle.

Red Wattles are wide or broad in their bodies and need broad set legs to balance the weight and support them.

The legs should be strong, thick and straight when normally standing and set on the corners of the body, front and rear.
